

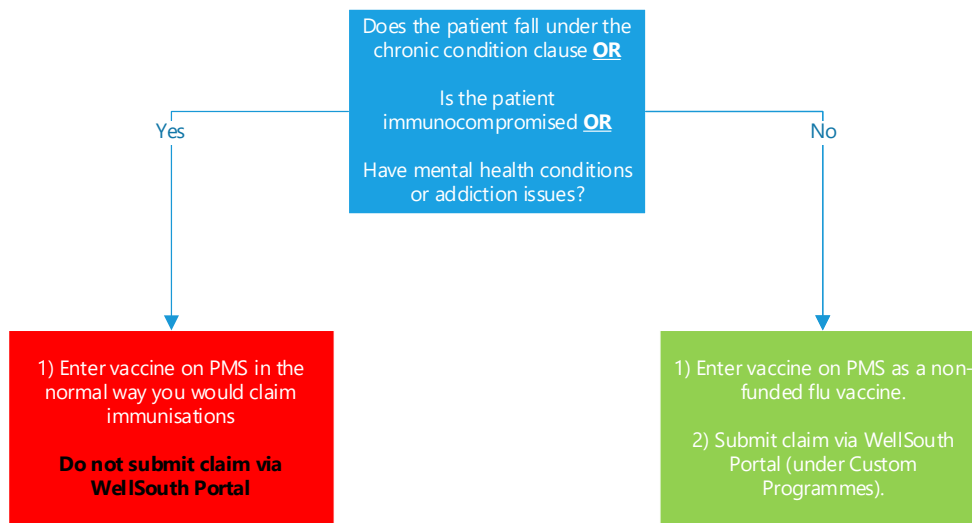
Influenza vaccine by WellSouth for General Practices

PHARMAC are not funding the flu vaccine for 55-64 year old Māori and Pasifika who do not have eligible conditions. See the eligibility details here [Pharmac eligibility criteria](#).

WellSouth is bridging the gap to ensure all 55-64 year old Māori and Pasifika are able to get a fully funded flu vaccine at their GP or pharmacy.

It is very important that you select the right funding stream when claiming the vaccine.

If your Māori and Pasifika patient aged 55-64 years old does not meet any of the Pharmac eligibility criteria, you may claim via the WellSouth PHN portal.



You will need to enter the following service code onto your PMS before you start claiming for this programme.
