



Gender Affirming Care

A programme by **WellSouth**

Intended Purpose

This programme supports our District alignment to national Gender Affirming Care guidelines and a shift to the informed consent model for Gender Affirming Hormone Therapy (GAHT) initiation. It enables Gender affirming care to be offered in the community, addresses barriers to care for transgender and non-binary patients while recognising clinicians time required for professional development and extended consults. The programme supports primary care GAHT prescribers who offer informed consent consults, including initiation of GAHT or as part of a referral for GAC surgery. Funding is intended for a series of extended consults for GAHT initiation or for consults related to GAC surgery. It is not intended for long term management once GAHT has been initiated, or for general health needs of transgender and non-binary patients.

Eligibility:

- Patients 18 years and over
- Eligible for funded health care and live in the Southern District.

Exclusions

- Requests from geographical areas outside of the Southern District

Key Information

- **Only** GAHT prescribing GPs and NPs who participated in the national Health NZ GAHT prescriber training or equivalent training and are connected to the national GAHT prescribers peer group can access this funding; there will be an initial accreditation assessment to determine eligibility.
- Funding is clinician specific:

If you are a GAHT prescriber and work in multiple practices, please email GenderAffirmingCare@wellsouth.org.nz

- Funding consists of two different claims types:
 - GAHT prescribers providing this care to patients **enrolled in their practice**
 - Experienced GAHT prescribers **accepting referrals from other practices**.
- Claims will be funded as a flat fee, with a limit of one claim, per patient, per year. There is flexibility in how the care is provided and what it covers, but generally it would be expected to cover: 2-5 consults with the prescriber, any associated nursing time (information collection, medication administration) and admin time associated with the process, including referrals.

To access funding, **each new patient** requires a referral via ERMS to General Practice – Gender Affirming Care Referral – WellSouth PHO

If you have a patient who is keen to explore GAHT and you do not have capacity or are not currently an accredited provider, please submit a referral via ERMS to General Practice – Gender Affirming Care Referral – WellSouth PHO and it will be triaged and on-referred to a provider with capacity. You will receive an acknowledgement with feedback indicating the details. Please ensure you have consented your patient to share information with another provider as appropriate and their preference for how to be contacted.

If the above clinician criteria are met, then claiming is available to all Southern District general practices, irrespective of PHO affiliation, including those non general practice health services who employ a GAHT prescribing GP or NP and provide regular care to their patients, even if they do not enrol them.

Claiming is via the WellSouth PHN portal.
