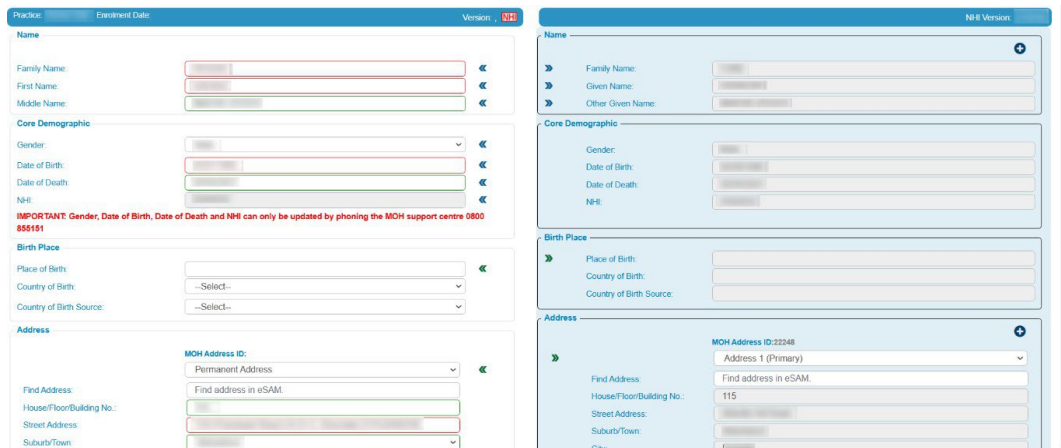


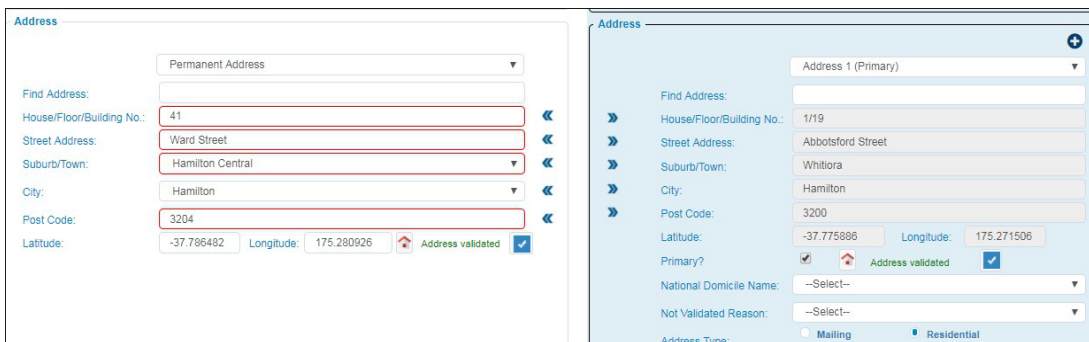
# Updating NHI in indici

## Enrolling a Patient

When you proceed to the NES stage of the enrolment process, you will see the NES Comparison screen. The screen displays the patient's data recorded in indici on the left-hand side, while the patient's data saved on the NHI is displayed on the right-hand side.



Before the patient can be enrolled with NES, their data must be the same on both the indici and the NHI, so this screen enables you to compare and identify any differences. If any of the data doesn't match (for example, if the patient's address has been changed on indici but not on the NHI) the system will alert you to this discrepancy by outlining the relevant fields in red:



You can use the arrows next to each field to transfer information contained in that field either from the indici side (in which case the relevant field on the NHI side will be updated to match the indici data) or from the NHI side (in which case the relevant field on the indici side will be updated to match the NHI data):



You can add certain types of data from the NHI side, for example, additional ethnicities, which you can then transfer across using the arrows as shown above:

It is important to note that any changes you make on this screen will have no impact on either the Indici database or the NHI database until you click the **Update and Sync. (Indici/NHI)** button:
