# Long Term Conditions Support – Toitū Takata Review Process

#### **User Guide**

#### Introduction

The review process provides you and your patient with the opportunity to reflect on the support they have received during their 12 months in the **Long Term Conditions Support – Toitū Takata** programme. Together, you can:

- Review the progress made.
- Update clinical and self-assessment information.
- Decide on next steps for managing the patient's long-term condition.

## **Accessing the Review Form**

The link to the review form will be available in the Current Programme menu in your PMS **51–60** weeks after the patient's enrolment.

Select New Long Term Conditions Support - Toitū Takata Review.



You will see the form has information from the patient's initial enrolment on the left side with fields to complete at the review on the right side

## Self-Assessment

Update the self assessment by click the green Questionnaire button.



#### **Observations**

• The latest **height, weight, waist circumference & blood pressure** will be prepopulated from the PMS, or can be entered manually.



## **Condition-Specific Information**

The following sections will appear depending on the patient's long-term condition(s) at enrolment.

### Cardiovascular / Stroke

### Blood tests:

- o Left side: Results from enrolment or within 2 months after enrolment.
- o Right side: Most recent results within 10 months prior to the review date.
- o If no recent results are available, an **alert** will appear (but the form can still be submitted).

## • Heart failure patients:

- o NYHA Functional Classification from enrolment displays on the left.
- Repeat the classification at review (access via the green Questionnaire button).



#### **Diabetes**

#### Blood tests:

- o Left side: Results from enrolment or within 2 months after enrolment.
- o Right side: Most recent results within 10 months prior to the review date.
- o If no recent results are available, an **alert** will appear (but the form can still be submitted).




#### Gout

#### • Blood tests:

- o Left side: Results from enrolment or within 2 months after enrolment.
- o Right side: Most recent results within 10 months prior to the review date.
- o If no recent results are available, an **alert** will appear (but the form can still be submitted).

## Gout flare ups:

- o Left side: Number of flare ups in the 12 months prior to enrolment.
- Right side: Review the number of flare ups during the 12 months of Toitū Takata support.
- Current CVD Risk pre-populates from the PMS if available.




## **Respiratory Disease**

## **Respiratory Function Test**

- Left side: Respiratory function test & number of exacerbations from enrolment.
- Right side:
  - Repeat the appropriate test at review (this may differ from the original test if the diagnosis has changed).

o Review & record the number of exacerbations in the last 12 months.



## Severe and Enduring Mental Illness and Addiction

## Blood tests:

- o Left side: Results from enrolment or within 2 months after enrolment.
- o Right side: Most recent results within 10 months prior to the review date.
- If no recent results are available, an alert will appear (but the form can still be submitted).


Free text fields for Clinical Evaluation and Patient Feedback



#### **Outcome**

At the end of the review, select either:

- Re-enrol in Toitū Takata (for a further 12 months)
- Discharge from the programme



NB: To re-enrol a new enrolment form is required

## Important notes on re-enrolment

To re-enrol a new enrolment form is required. You can access the form either from the link in the review summary after submitting your claim, or from your PMS portal (as usual).



Patients initially enrolled with a **newly diagnosed LTC** may not be eligible for re-enrolment.

- If you select **Re-enrolment**, you must also confirm one of the following:
  - The patient's demographics have changed (e.g., they now have a CSC or HUHC).
  - The patient has been **newly diagnosed with another LTC**.
- These claims will be reviewed by WellSouth.
- If neither option applies, the patient is **not eligible for re-enrolment**.
  - An alert will appear.
  - You must change the outcome to **Discharged from Programme** before the claim can be submitted.

## Important notes on discharge

Don't forget to update your recalls when discharging patients from Toitū Takata including:

- Funded CVDRA for those with severe & enduring mental illness
- Diabetes annual reviews etc
