

SEXUAL HEALTH

There are two groups who will qualify for the Sexual Health Programme

This programme allows for all aspects of sexual health, including contraceptive care. We ask providers to note that there will only be two funded visits within a 12 month period from first visit date per patient i.e. if a patient presents for their first visit on the 12th September this year they are entitled to one more visit before the 12th September next year. Patients must be enrolled at the time of this service being provided.

Criteria: High Needs Patients

- Maori, Pacific, Quintile 5, CSC or HUHC holder
- Patients must be enrolled with the Practice
- Maximum age limit of up to 50 years
- No lower age limit
- Maximum of 2 consultations per patient within 12 month period
- Programme available to both male and female patients
- This programme is not available to casual patients
- Appropriate advice and education given

Criteria: Non-High Needs Patients

- Outside Dunedin and Invercargill
- Patients must be enrolled with the Practice
- Maximum age limit of up to 22 years

- No lower age limit
- Maximum of 2 consultations per patient within 12 month period
- Programme available to both male and female patients
- This programme is not available to casual patients
- Appropriate advice and education given
