Intended Purpose

The aim of this programme is to ensure that patients who have a positive FIT (faecal immunochemical test) test are seen by their GP and offered a referral for colonoscopy.

Eligibility

• Patients aged 60-74 who have had a positive fit result, notified to their general practice, this must have been via the national screening programme.

Exclusions

- Patients with historic or current bowel cancer.
- Colonoscopy within last 5 years.
- Already on surveillance programme (polyps, bowel cancer, family history, IBD (inflammatory bowel disease)).
- Current treatment for IBD.
- Those currently experiencing symptoms (see GP outside of screening programme).
- Patients who have had a result via an over the counter iFOBT (immunochemical faecal occult blood test) kit.

Key Information

- Please advise the patient of their positive test results within 10 working days of the result being reported.
 Claims older than 10 working days will be rejected.
- In person or phone consults are allowed at clinician discretion.
- Discuss results and eligibility/suitability for colonoscopy. Claim may still be made if no referral is indicated.
- Refer as appropriate to public or private colonoscopy provider based on patient preference.
