IV Fluids can be given to patients with conditions as outlined below in a general practice setting if they are preventing a hospital admission or presentation.

Presenting conditions available within the portal for this programme are:

- Hyperemesis
- Pyelonephritis
- Dehydration
- Renal Colic
- Other (must specify in portal)

Exclusions

• Fluids given to patients who will be transferred to hospital cannot be claimed under this programme. E.g. not for stabilising a patient before transport.
