

Viewing Diabetes Audit Patients

Diabetes Mini Audit 1 – New Diagnosis Classifications and Recalls

Māori who are Diabetics

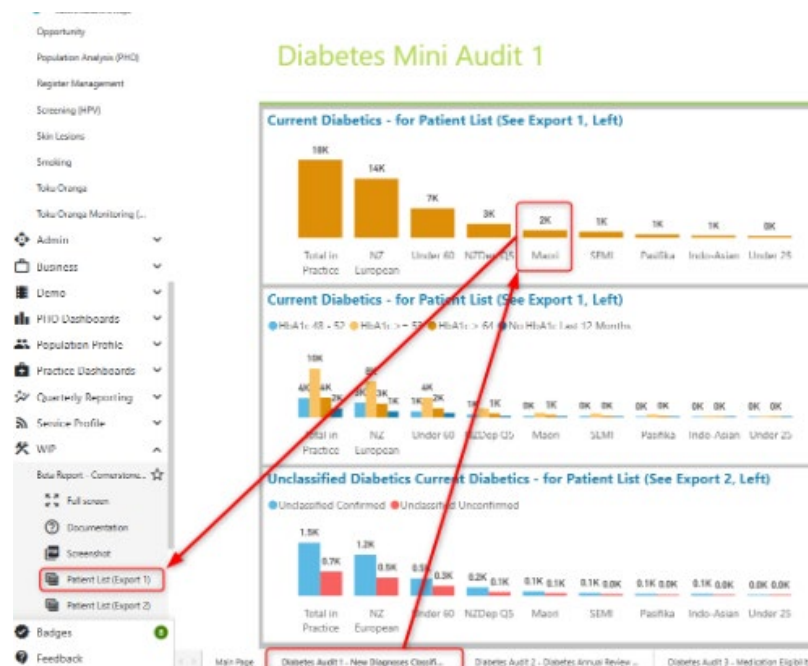


Figure 1 Current Diabetics who are Māori

1. Click on the bar labelled Māori on the bar chart “Current Diabetics – for Patient List (See Export 1, Left)” to view the patient list (Figure 1).
2. Click **Patient List (Export 1)** on the left navigation bar to view or print the list.
 - This gives you a list of all Māori patients who are current diabetics.

Māori who are Unclassified but Confirmed Diabetics

1. For unclassified diabetics, click on the bar labelled Māori as well as Unclassified Confirmed on the bar chart “Unclassified Diabetics – for Patient List (See Export 2, Left)” (Figure 2).
2. Click **Patient List (Export 2)** to view or print the list.
 - This gives you all Māori Unclassified Confirmed patients.

Diabetes Mini Audit 2 - Diabetes Annual Review

Māori who never had a DAR

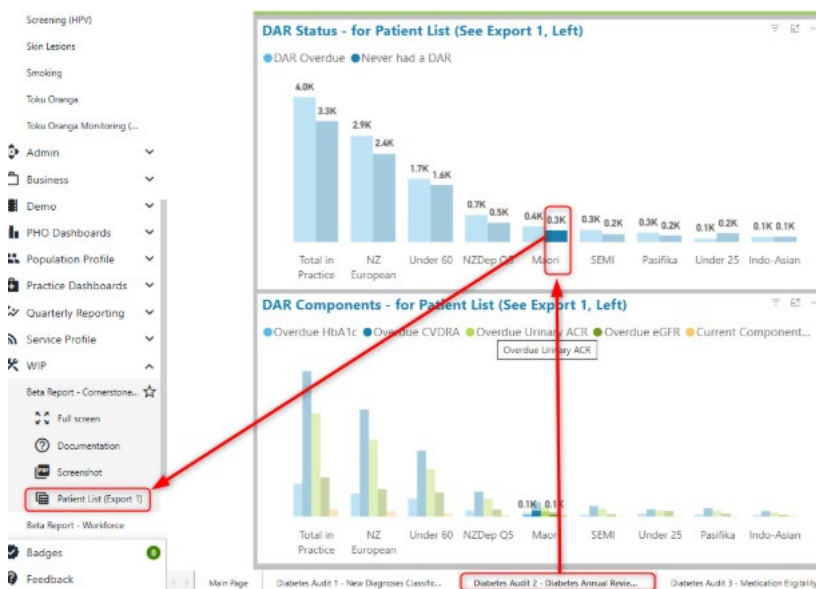


Figure 3 DAR Status – Māori Patients Who Have Never Had a DAR

1. Click on the bar labelled Māori on the bar chart “DAR Status – for Patient List (See Export 1, Left)” to view the patient list (Figure 3).
2. Click **Patient List (Export 1)** to view or print the list.
 - This gives you a list of all Māori patients who have never had a DAR.

All Diabetics who are Overdue for CVDRA (DAR Components)

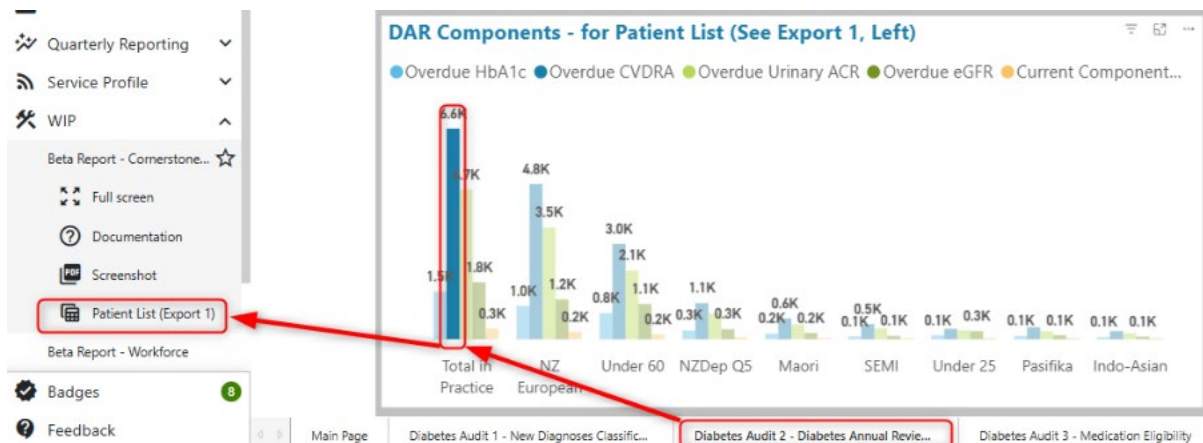


Figure 4 DAR Components – All Patients Overdue for CVDRA

1. Click on the Overdue CVDRA bar in the Total in Practice column on the bar chart “DAR Components – for Patient List (See Export 1, Left)” to view the patient list (Figure 4).
2. Click **Patient List (Export 1)** to view or print the list.
 - This gives you all your patients who are overdue for CVD Risk Assessment.

Diabetes Mini Audit 3 – Medication Eligibility

Māori Eligible for New Medication who are Never Prescribed

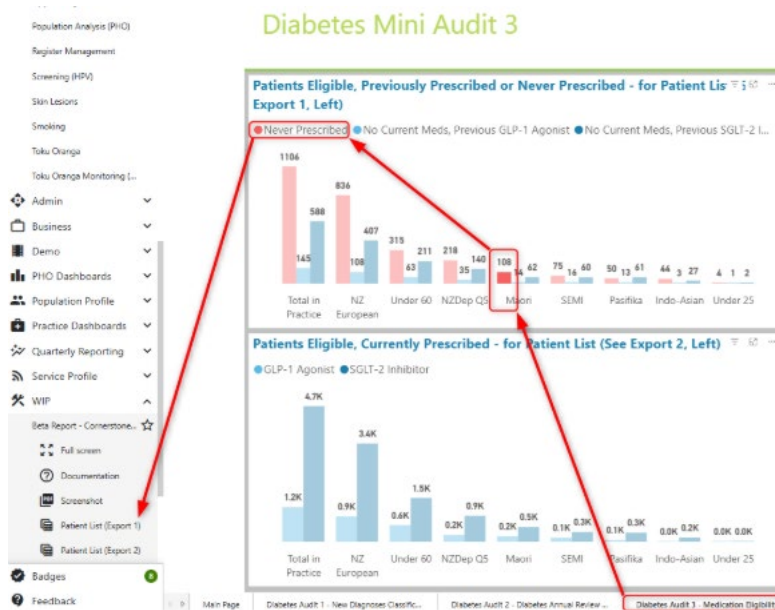


Figure 5 Patients Eligible, Previously Prescribed or Never Prescribed – Māori

1. Click on the bar labelled Māori under Never Prescribed on the bar chart “Patients Eligible, Previously Prescribed or Never Prescribed – for Patient List (Export 1, Left)” to view the patient list (Figure 5).
2. Click **Patient List (Export 1)** to view or print the list.
 - This gives you a list of all Māori patients eligible for medication who have never been prescribed it.

All Patients who are Eligible for New Medication who are Currently Prescribed

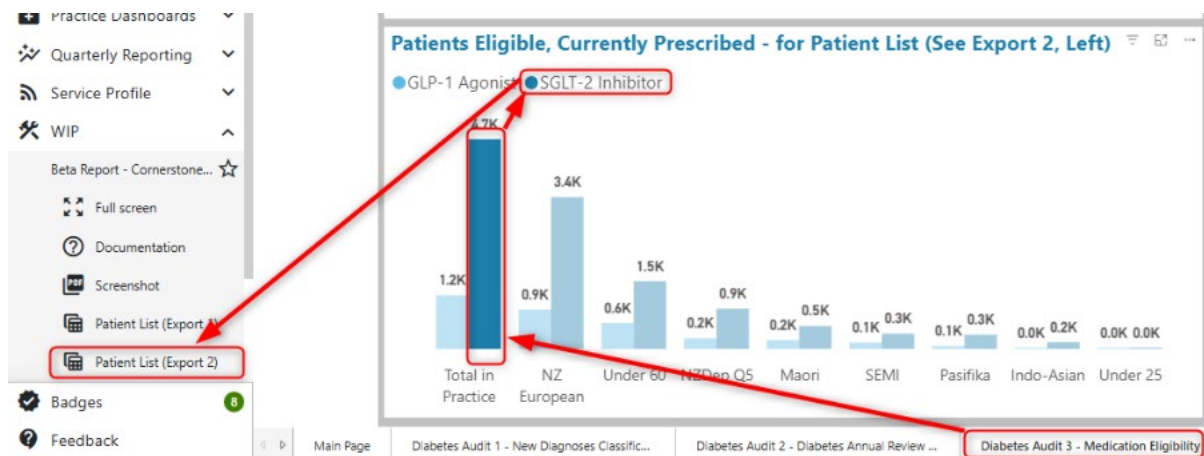


Figure 6 Patients Eligible, Currently Prescribed – SGLT-2 Inhibitor

Click on the bar labelled SGLT-2 Inhibitor in the Total in Practice column on the bar chart “Patients Eligible, Currently Prescribed – for Patient List (See Export 2, Left)” to view the patient list (Figure 6).

1. Click **Patient List (Export 2)** to view or print the list.

- This gives you a list of all patients currently prescribed SGLT-2 inhibitors in the practice.
