CPR Updates / Drop In Sessions

In 2023 we are changing how we offer CPR/Immediate Life Support training and certification at WellSouth.

Prior to attending an in person physical skills assessment we will be requiring people complete the appropriate online training and assessment on Health Learn via this link. If you do not have Health Learn access or are having trouble, please email HealthLearn@wellsouth.org.nz and we will be able to help get you set up, or help you access your existing account.

Once you have completed your online assessment, you will need to bring proof of completion with you to an in person session / skills assessment. It is in the in person session where you will demonstrate on the CPR mannequin and receive your final assessment. Dates and locations for these can be found here via our workforce calendar. Registration will be required.

Its important to note that you will need to complete both the online and in person component for a valid CPR certification.
